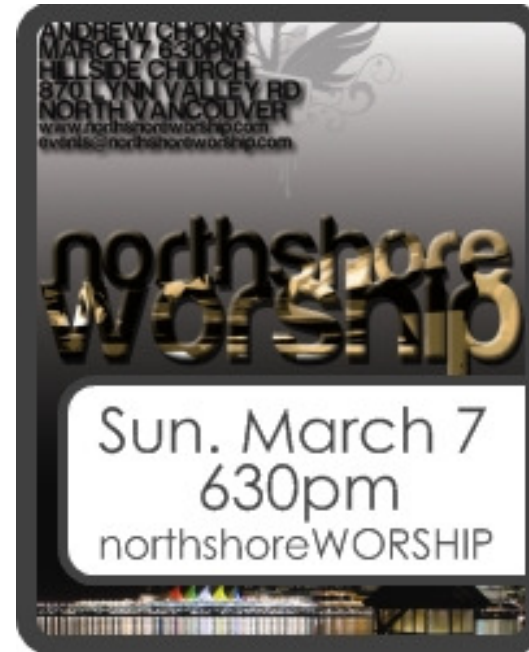

- **Desks Available** We have three desks available to a good home! If anyone is interested, speak with Owen Beaton.

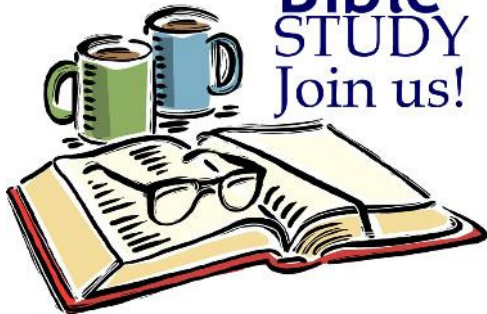
